Kindergarten Registration

Superintendent Carey reviewed the following discussion items with the Board of Education:

Registration in Community Unit School District 201 for incoming kindergarten students for the 2019-2020 school year will take place at both J.T. Manning Elementary School and C.E. Miller Elementary School beginning Tuesday, March 5 through, Friday, March 8, 2019 and Monday, March 11, 2019 - 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. CUSD 201 offers a full day Kindergarten program at Manning and Miller as well as a full day Bilingual Kindergarten program (housed at Miller Elementary for all district kindergarten students).

If you are unable to register on the assigned days, please contact the school office to make other arrangements. Please note that it is not necessary for children to accompany their parents/guardians to be registered.

The Joint Committee met on Tuesday, January 15. The Facility and Finance Committee reviewed the staffing and budget timeline and discussed the 5-year capital development plan and the 10-year Life Safety Plan. The Committee will be meeting later in the spring to review the two reports in detail.
