SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Carey reviewed the following discussion items with the Board of Education:

Summer School Report

The Summer School program was well attended. Student daily attendance was up from previous years. Thirty-four credits were recovered in the High School Credit Recovery Course. Of the twenty-six students enrolled, twenty-five students recovered their recommended credits.

After the fall testing results have been compiled, we will be able to see if the students benefited academically. The anecdotal data has been very positive. Students and staff reported that they

enjoyed the experience.

Mr. Carey stated that there is a list of the dates and times for the various student recognition events; it will be circulated to the Board. Board Members may sign up for the events they would like to attend.

Mrs. Coyle requested that a discussion item regarding Student Recognition be placed on the agenda at the September 24, 2019, regular meeting of the Board of Education.

Student Recognition

At the last Board Meeting, a parent shared that she and other parents were not receiving the daily announcements from the Junior High and the High School.

On August 28, 2019, Nadine Norris reached out to the parent to ask for her help to gather more details for the e-alert issue. Nadine also opened a tech support case with Blackboard.

Communications

Mrs. Norris began tracking the parent and other parents to determine if they were receiving the e-alert announcements.

In the meantime, we have been in daily contact with Blackboard. When Nadine opened the case, she sent the names and email addresses of all families who subscribe to the HS and JH announcements. At first, Blackboard denied there was a problem. Next, they recommended that we "white-list" several web addresses. Jim confirmed that those web addresses were already white-listed in our domain. On Friday, August 29, they walked Jim through making a change to our DNS server. They said that this "might work" to fix the problem. When the issue persisted on Tuesday, September 3, Jim, based on his research, adjusted the DNS server. After numerous interactions with the tech support team, Nadine emailed the manager of client support. This morning, I received an email that they are escalating our case to the system engineers.

Nadine expects Blackboard to solve the issue with e-alerts. However, based on the interaction with Support from Blackboard and knowing how communication tools have evolved, she is exploring other options to send out daily announcements.

Mrs. Charlton requested that an email be sent to parents from the Principals at Westmont Junior High School and Westmont High School to let them know that there were problems with recent email alerts, however, the problem has been fixed.

A recently received FOIA request was shared with the Board of Education.

The August 28, 2019, edition of the Alliance Legislative Report was shared with the Board of Education.

Mrs. Strohmaier shared the positive feedback that she received regarding Compact 8CC Math at Westmont Junior High School.
