DISCUSSION/INFORMATION Presentation of Fiscal Year 2020 Audit

Susan Jones, CPA, MBA, with Miller Cooper & Co., Ltd., presented the Board the 2020 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR), which can be viewed online via Board Docs. Ms. Jones went through the CAFR with the Board and explained what the different sections of the CAFR are and some highlights.

- The Certificate of Excellence the District received for the 2019 CAFR. The District intends to submit again for the 2020 CAFR.
- Pages 1-4 Independent Auditors' Report The District received an unmodified opinion which is the highest level of assurance the district can receive.
- Pages 5-18 Management Discussion and Analysis –
 These pages provide a great overview of the CAFR
- Page 19 Statement of Position This is the heart of the financial Statements. It contains all the assets and liabilities, current and long term. The district ended with a net position of \$9.8 million, a slight decrease from 2019
- Page 20 Statement of Activities There was a slight net decrease.

- Page 21-22 Balance Sheet This is a list of all major funds and funds of the District. There is a total combined balance of 18.2 million. The General Fund has a certain assigned fund balance due to a donation to the high school. In the O&M Fund 242k was generated from the TIF for specific infrastructure spending.
- Page 23 Great Reconciliation Takes full accrual and statement of net position and reconciles it to the balance sheet.
- Page 24-25 Major Funds of the District Each of the major funds of the district. Shows all the revenues received offset by all the expenditure of 2020.
- Page 28 Fiduciary Funds These have all the student activity funds as well as the trust fund. This cash is currently not in the statements of the general fund. New legislation will require these funds to be included in the general fund next year, 2021.
- Page 30-80 Notes to the Financial Statements. There
 were no significant changes to accounting policies this
 year. All significant accounting policies are disclosed
 in the financial statements. If you wanted to do a
 deeper dive in the statements these would be included
 in the notes.
- Page 82 Pension Liabilities Would like to point out the IMRF fund is 98% funded this year. Last year was unusual and poor investment returns loss of about 1 million, but this year their investment return generated 3.1 million.
- Page 92 Detailed expenditure of the district compared to the budget
- Last section is statistical information from the past 10 year.

Ms. Jones reviewed the Required Communications Letter. The audit was executed in accordance of the Government Auditing Standards. They do not issue a separate opinion on internal controls only on financial statements and their fairness in relation to general acceptable accounting practices. The planning, scope, and timing of the audit was in line with what was outlined in the engagement letter. The firm is independent of the district. Ms. Jones would really like to thank Kim Anderson and Kevin Carey for their transparency and being ready when they come in to do the audit. The extra effort from them was appreciated.

Superintendent Carey presented to the Board information from the Illinois State Report Card on the State of the District. This year there is less information to share because there was no iAR or SAT testing in the spring, that would normally be included. Superintendent Carey presented the following:
