The school is 18 miles west of Chicago and serves a suburban residential area of approximately 25,000 people. Students live in sections of Westmont, Clarendon Hills, and Downers Grove.

School

The Fall 2013 enrollment at Westmont High School is 456 students, with 139 seniors in the Class of 2014. The average composite ACT score in the Class of 2014 is 20.8. The average per pupil operating cost in the 2011-2012 school year was \$15,818.66.

Organization of School Year

The school year consists of four quarters, each nine weeks long. The day is divided into seven 50-minute periods. The first semester ends on January 10, 2014, and the second semester ends on May 30, 2014.
